
What Can I Do With Fear?

- ... Fear of missing out (FOMO)
- ... Fear of the future
- ... Fear of knowing yourself
- ... Fear of other people knowing the real you

Proverbs 2:1-5 "if-then" statements about really knowing God

My child, **if** you accept my words and store up my commands within you,

- ² turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding—
- ³ indeed, **if** you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding,
- ⁴ and **if** you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure,
- ⁵ t**hen** you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God.
